## BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

December 15, 2004

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. The following items were discussed.

1. The budget for 2005 was discussed at great length. Many items should remain close to the 2004 budget while others will vary. Like any budget, it is designed to give us a guide and many items are only an educated guess.
2. At present it appears that we are solvent, will be able to meet our mortgage payment, and make the purchase of the two Blanik L-13's a reality followed by the sale of our 2-33's.
3. One direction that the discussion took was the concern over the very light attendance at the January Annual Membership meeting last year. Every Nutmeg member should consider this meeting as the most important meeting of the year. The final budget is set at this meeting and your slate of officers will be chosen. Please plan to attend and pick your officers and tell them how you want your money spent. **This year's meeting will be held on January 14<sup>th</sup> at the Bethany Town Hall starting at 7:00 PM sharp. Be There!**
4. Bill Kenyon has submitted 3 different grant requests.
  - a. \$40,000 to purchase the rock ledge land East of our airport.
  - b. \$100,000 for runway stabilization
  - c. \$300,000 for completely rebuilding the runway
5. Bill also placed large white crosses at the approach area to the runway and NOTAMS indicating Prior permission is required to land at this time.
6. Obtaining ribs for the Pawnee wing is turning out to be a slow process. It is reasonable to assume that we will find them.
7. Tom Albrecht built an excellent paint spray booth for work being done on the Pawnee. A large fan is still needed to complete the job. This was a big effort on Tom's behalf.
8. Progress on paint removal has been very good. Dave Jackson made bows the shape of the outer wing tips and primer painted some of the steel wing parts.
9. Letters to Fed X will be sent in an effort to get them moving on the insurance Payment.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM
